On September 24, 1860, a group of progressive sheep producers joined forces to market their wool. At that time, gaining access to the Boston wool market was the most pressing issue facing California sheep producers.

In response, these producers procured a ship to haul their wool "around the horn" to the wool markets on the east coast. While there, these producers witnessed the beginning of the Civil War and the growing demand for wool.


As a result, the California Wool Growers Association was established to be the unifying voice of the California sheep industry.
