Coming from Bay Area/Vacaville- Take 1-505N to Co Rd 27 in Yolo County. Take Exit 17 from I-505N. Turn left onto Co Rd 27. Turn right at 2nd cross street onto Co Rd 89. Turn left at Co Rd 25. Drive approximately 4.6 mi to the headquarters/cattle corral area.

Coming from Sacramento- Take 1-5N. Take exit 541 for CA-16 W toward Esparto. Continue on CA-16 W. Turn left onto Co Rd 89. Turn right onto Co Rd 25. Drive approximately 4.6 mi to the headquarters/cattle corral area.
