Her other objective is to double the number of California's contestants in next year's contest and continue to grow the contest each following year.

The California Junior and Senior winners will compete in the National Make It With Wool Contest January 20-23, 2022 in San Diego at the Sheraton. The Adult winner will compete in a mail-in contest and the winner of the mail-in contest will participate in the National Fashion Show in San Diego.
